Are you aware that animals can spread some diseases and parasites to humans?

Are any individuals living at your residence allergic to animals?

Are you aware that it can take weeks, and sometimes months, for an animal to adjust to a new home?

Have you researched your local, state, and federal laws and licensing concerning the animal you wish to foster?

Do you plan on moving within the next three (3) years?

Do you understand that we do not approve applications on a "first-come, first-serve" basis?

Do you understand that we reserve the right to deny applications for any reason?

Do you understand that we do not approve applicants who have been convicted of animal neglect, abuse, and/or cruelty?

Are you fully committed to providing some financial responsibility for the fostered animal?



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Foster Agreement

This Foster Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") is hereby considered a contractual Agreement between Fullmer Menagerie Animal Rescue (hereinafter referred to as "FMAR", "our", "us", or "we"), a registered non-profit 501-(c) (3) organization existing under the laws of the state of Utah in the United States of America, and the below signed individual (hereinafter referred to as the "Applicant", "you", or "your").

This Foster Application (hereinafter referred to as the "Application"), including this Agreement, is subject to review and processing by our staff and/or Director. We attempt to process applications within seventy-two (72) hours, however, it may take up to twenty-one (21) days to complete processing. By submitting this Application and signing this Agreement, you hereby acknowledge and agree to the following:

1. We reserve the right to refuse and/or deny your Application, for any reason, and the right to withhold from you why a refusal/denial was made.
2. We do not discriminate against any applicant, in any way, based on any protected classes (e.g. age, gender, race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation or identity, etc.).
3. Your Application will be valid for sixty (60) days from the date of approval.
4. Your Application will not be approved if you are under the age of eighteen (18), unless express written permission is provided to us by your parent or legal guardian.
5. Your Application will not be approved if you, or any individual currently living with you, has been criminally or civilly convicted with animal neglect, animal abuse, and/or animal cruelty.
6. If we determine, at our sole discretion, that you have submitted this Application with false and/or misleading information, your Application will be denied.
7. You may be required to submit additional information upon our request in order to complete application processing.
8. Your Application is not, and will not, be considered "first-come, first-serve." Our Director will evaluate all applications for a specific animal and determine which applicant will provide the best care and who demonstrates the best possible availability.
9. You are fostering this animal for our organization and will not gift, give away, sell, trade, or otherwise relinquish the animal to any other shelter, rescue, organization, or individual. We fully retain all legal ownership rights to the animal.
10. You are fostering this animal as a companion animal and will not subject the animal to any activities that promote aggressive behavior and/or could cause injury and/or death to the animal.
11. You shall allow a representative from our organization to enter onto your property and into your residence to complete a residence inspection. Applications will not be approved until a residence inspection is completed. Certain exceptions may apply and are handled on a case-by-case basis by our Director.
12. You shall provide the animal with adequate, humane, and animal-specific food and water every day, in the amount recommended by a licensed veterinarian.
13. You shall provide the animal with adequate, humane, and safe shelter, whether the animal resides indoors and/or outdoors.
14. You shall provide the animal with routine, humane, and safe exercise for at least one (1) hour per day, or as recommended by a licensed veterinarian.
15. You shall provide the animal with proper training while in your care which includes, but is not limited to: (a) leash/walk training; (b) kennel training; (c) potty training; (d) obedience training; and (e) behavioral training.
16. You shall provide the animal with proper grooming while in your care, as recommended by a licensed veterinarian.
17. You shall provide the animal with routine veterinary exams conducted by a licensed veterinarian of our choosing, for as often as recommended by a licensed veterinarian. You are responsible for transporting the animal to and from these veterinary exams. If you fail to transport the animal to and from any scheduled veterinary exams, we may revoke your right to foster for our organization and you will be required to immediately relinquish the animal back to us.
18. You shall seek immediate emergency care in the event that the animal becomes sick or injured, which shall be completed by a licensed veterinarian.
19. You shall secure and maintain all applicable local, state, and federal licenses required to maintain the legal right to have the animal where you reside.
20. You shall keep complete records for the animal, including all veterinary exams and procedures, vaccinations, treatments, medications, and licenses. We reserve the right to request copies of any and all records for the animal at any time, and for any reason.
21. In the event that you foster a dog or cat, you will provide the animal with a collar, to be worn at all times, complete with all applicable license tags, rabies tags, and identification tags with your current information, as well as our current information.
22. You shall only utilize positive-reinforcement on the animal. Under no circumstance shall you employ negative-reinforcement, or any other disciplinary action that could cause the animal discomfort or distress, development of behavior or temperament issues, or injury and/or death.
23. You shall transport the animal in a safe and humane manner while traveling in any type of vehicle. Under no circumstance shall you transport the animal in a way that could

cause the animal discomfort, distress, or injury and/or death.

24. You shall immediately contact us in the event that you cannot keep the animal and will immediately relinquish the animal to our organization. You will not gift, give away, sell, trade, or otherwise relinquish the animal to any other shelter, rescue, organization, or individual.
25. You shall contact us in the event that the animal is missing for more than twenty-four (24) hours, or if the animal is stolen.
26. You shall notify us of any change in your contact information, which includes your physical address, phone number, and email address.
27. You shall contact us in the event that the animal dies, whether by euthanasia, accident, illness, injury, or natural causes.
28. If euthanasia becomes necessary, you shall have a licensed veterinarian of our choosing complete the procedure at a veterinary clinic only.
29. In the event that you wish to adopt the animal you are fostering, you will be required to complete an adoption application. The adoption fee may be waived and is handled on a case-by-case basis by our Director.
30. All expenses that you may incur from, and only related to, fostering the animal, may be reimbursed by us depending on specific conditions. Conditions that warrant possible reimbursement include, but are not limited to: (a) scheduled veterinary exams; (b) transportation-related costs; and/or (c) required items, medications, grooming, etc. that the animal must have. Conditions that do not warrant reimbursement include, but are not limited to: (d) food for the animal; (e) emergency veterinary care due to negligence; and/or (f) items purchased for the animal that were not approved by our Director. Certain exceptions may apply and are handled on a case-by-case basis by our Director.
31. We may not know, nor are we required to produce, guarantee, or warrant, the past history of the animal. This includes, but is not limited to, any previous owners, residences, shelters, rescues, etc.
32. We accept no responsibility, nor do we make any representations, guarantees, or warranties, as to the animals present or future health, treatment, and/or genetic conditions. You understand that this animal may be prone to health and/or genetic conditions not readily evident. Liable for any costs, charges, fees, expenses, or other financial burden related to the health of the animal while in your care will be handled on a case-by-case basis by our Director.
33. We accept no responsibility, nor do we make any representations, guarantees, or warranties, as to the animals present or future behavior, temperament, and/or demeanor. You understand that this animal may be prone to behavioral, temperamental, or other problems related to the animals demeanor, including problems that may cause damage, harm, illness, injury and/or death to persons and/or property. We will not be held liable for any costs, charges, fees, expenses, or otherwise financial burden related to the behavioral and/or temperamental problems of the animal while in your care, including without limitation, any and all related legal fees, costs, expenses, attorneys fees, settlements, payouts, or other court-ordered financial compensation and/or legal responsibility due to the animals actions or causes of actions.
34. You hereby agree and warrant that you have the actual legal power, right, and authority to enter into this Agreement.
35. You acknowledge and agree to forever release, discharge, and covenant to hold harmless FMAR, and any of our staff, volunteers, or Directors, chargeable with responsibility or liability, their heirs, administrators, executors, successors, and assigns from any and all claims, damages, costs, expenses, loss of service, actions and causes of action belonging to you arising out of any act or occurrence for the present time and particularly on account of the fostering of the animal.
36. You acknowledge and agree to allow us to periodically inspect the animal and the animals living conditions to ensure compliance with this Agreement. This may include residence inspections, phone calls, text messages, and/or email communications. We reserve the right to complete these inspections at any time, and without prior notice.
37. You acknowledge and agree that we retain the full and legal right to relinquish the animal from you when warranted, for any reason, which includes neglect, abuse, inadequate home or veterinary care, or breach of contract. You agree to voluntarily, without hesitation or reprimand, relinquish custody of the animal immediately upon our written request without legal writ or order.
38. You acknowledge and agree that in the event it is necessary for FMAR to take legal action to recover the animal or otherwise enforce the provisions in this Agreement, you hereby agree to pay any and all legal fees and court costs incurred by FMAR.
39. Any changes or additional terms to this Agreement must be in the form of an Addendum and signed by all parties to this Agreement.
